About the Campus Leader Program

Teach For Pakistan's Campus Leader Program embodies our core belief that the development of our future leaders will ultimately shape our own future; the future of Pakistan. This six-month experience is a unique opportunity for students to join the Teach For Pakistan movement for educational equity so that one day, all of Pakistan's children have an education that enables them to be loving, thinking and engaged citizens.

Teach For Pakistan's Campus Leaders (CLs) not only develop their own leadership skills but take on the charge of ensuring that Pakistan's most outstanding talent is solving one of its most critical issues; *Educational inequity*.

Who we are

Teach For Pakistan is a nationwide movement of outstanding graduates and young professionals who commit two years to teach in under-resourced schools, and go on to become lifelong leaders working across all fields to expand educational opportunity. After the Fellowship, our Alumni use their experiences to tackle Pakistan's most pressing problems in education, fostering action to change policy and curriculum, mobilizing resources, turning around schools, and spurring social innovation. Collectively, this movement aims to transform systems of educational inequity and promote excellence in education. What the role entails

- Design and execute an advocacy campaign on your campus to deepen the understanding of education inequity in Pakistan and build a desire for equitable education for Pakistan in your network.
- Manage relationships with key stakeholders on campus in order to strengthen the dialogue about the crisis of education in Pakistan.
- Inspire dedicated and persevering students to invest their potential in solving one of the most pressing challenges of Pakistan: education inequity.
- Support the recruitment team by connecting interested candidates to the Teach For Pakistan team in order to ensure that the Fellowship application is accessible to students with a passion for equity in education and plan to develop their leadership by completing the Teach For Pakistan Fellowship.

Who we look for:

An applicant must:

- Be passionate about equity in education in Pakistan, and care deeply about the future of Pakistan's children;
- Be enrolled in the 3rd or 4th year of an Undergraduate program or in a graduate program;
- Have demonstrated excellence in a leadership role in their professional, academic or co-curricular experiences;
- Possess strong critical thinking, problem solving and project management skills;
- Is able to communicate effectively with various stakeholders, and mobilize them to work collaboratively for a shared cause;

What we offer

- An opportunity to work with and learn from the Teach For Pakistan leadership development team;
- A chance to build your project management skills by designing and executing an advocacy campaign and presenting your project to a panel of distinguished professionals for feedback;
- Development and strengthening of your professional skills by receiving training from the country's premier leadership development program;
- A chance to qualify for the penultimate stage of selection for the Teach For Pakistan Fellowship;
- An opportunity to network with leaders across the Teach For All network and learn from the work that partners are doing in 50+ countries;
- A chance to qualify for the Teach For Pakistan summer internship program in 2023;
